Reminder: Even though Conditions Say for Racing Sat or Sun these conditions are for the entire weekend. Once the races fill we will allocate the days they will run.

the STARTER ALLOWANCE SERIES - it is NOT under the stakes preferences.

Coggins papers must be in the office before arriving at the race track, this is a mandatory requirement of HRA.

Entries on TUESDAYS prior to the race weekend entries open at 7:30am – Entries Close by 9:30am for the entire weekend

If you are on the race track enter in person at the race office

RMTC will be putting out **one condition sheet** for racing each weekend (Even though conditions say to race Fri. Sat. Sun. or Mon, it is for racing the entire weekend. Days will be allocated after entries.

Physical HORSE REGISTRATION PAPERS MUST be in the race office prior to entering for the weekend.

DIGITAL HORS PAPERS MUST be transferred to the race office in LETHBRIDGE prior to entry day and must have correct OWNER/TRAINER. **If the horse has been foaled in Canada it MUST have Canadian registration papers.**

REMINDER: Make sure that your digital Horse Papers are sent to the race track select LETHBRIDGE. If digital papers are at another race track have them transfer to LETHBRIDGE.

Horsemen's Cheque request must be in the request book in the Race Office, Sunday by 4:30pm and will ready by the following Friday. Horsemen owner cheques will be done **ONCE** a week.

- Horsemen Cheques must be requested half hour after last race on Sundays (or Holiday Monday)

PREFERENCES DATE

- A horse that has been entered at the meet will have an Entry Date that will be recognized for any condition
- Horses that run will receive a running date corresponding to the "**WEEKEND** OF" that they run and lose the date previously held.
- **Race Days**, race track is closed at 9:30am. Other days TBA by race office.
- **FOR ALL STAKE RACES AND ALL RACES HOUSE SILKS MUST BE WORN.**

IF YOU HAVE AN **ALTERNATE RACE** PLEASE PUT ON IT ON YOUR ENTRY SLIP AT YOUR TIME OF ENTRY.

No horses will be transferred to an alternate race unless the Original race is called off.

NOTE: ENTRIES WILL ONLY be taken by entering in person at the race office or by talking directly to an entry clerk. NO entries will be taken by leaving a voicemail, or fax, or email, or text.

SEE THE RACE OFFICE FOR ALL RMTC POLICIES and FIRE EVACUATION PROCEDURES.

NOTE:

On Entry days, horses that are entered and we declare entered horses are preferred, the horses will be carded and cannot be withdrawn.

JOCKEYS Check the race office for jockeys riding Jockey weight is 124 to 134 lbs

Name at least 2 jockeys (or more) on your entry slip

TIMED WORKS

All Breds and all races. - Horses must have a qualified work within **30 days** prior to racing..

A Timed Work form **must** be filled out by the trainer and given to the clocker at the back gate by the Blue Barn before the horse goes on the track for the timed work.

Timed works and gate approvals/works are weather permitting will be announced each week.

Fill out the timed work sheets for timed works and timed gate works and give to the clocker.

VET CHECKS ON RACE DAYS

Reminder all horses must be on the grounds *before* 10:00am on race days for vet checks. Vet starts at the shipin barn at 7:00am. If your horse is on the vets list (or any list) it is the trainers responsibility to have it taken off the list.

>TAKE ENTRY SLIPS AND FILL THEM OUT THEN DROP THEM OFF EARLY IN THE MORNING if YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO COME AND ENTER EARLY ON ENTRY DAY!

> COGGINS PAPERS MUST BE IN THE RACE OFFICE PRIOR TO SHIPPING ONTO THE RACE TRACK THIS IS FOR ALL HORSES, RACE HORSES, PONY HORSES ETC.

> CANADIAN BRED HORSE PAPERS – in order to race if your horse is Canadian Bred you must have your horse paper registered with CTHS.

WAIVER CLAIMING 2026 as of April 28, 2026

Waiver Claiming – even though the claiming races do not specify it is waiver claiming all claiming races have option to waiver claim if eligible. Mark the waiver claim on entry slip or if phoning in identify when entering.

(A) At the time of entry into a claiming race, the owner may opt to declare a horse ineligible to be claimed provided:

(1) The horse has not started since Nov 1, 2025 – (which was the final day of racing in Alberta).

(2) The horse is entered for a claiming price equal to or greater than the price at which it last started.

(B) Failure to declare the horse eligible is the responsibility of the trainer at the time of entry-this may not be remedied.

(C) Waiver claiming races will be written for the first 3 weekends of racing. With a bonus the 4th weekend.*

***BONUS WAIVER:** A horse can receive a second waiver if they run twice in the first four weeks. There will not be waivers for horses that enter the fourth week for the first time. A horse that wins a waiver race will not be eligible to use a waiver for the claiming level of the win. The horse can use the second waiver at a higher level.

Also

If horses enter at a higher claiming price than their last start on or before Nov. 1, 2025 they are still eligible to start at Nov. move to a higher claiming to use 2nd waiver.

EG. If a horse's last start Nov. 1, 2025 or earlier was for Claiming \$4,000 and it entered today for \$5,000 and did not win the race it is still eligible to run waiver \$4,000 for its second waiver race.

When parking horse trailers in the jockey parking lot park within 3 feet of the last one parked. DO NOT PUT MANURE AROUND THE WALKERS PUT IN THE MANURE BINS. TURN OFF LIGHTS IN THE BARN WHEN YOU ARE NOT IN THE BARN AND ALSO AT NIGHT
